
The intending tenderers may inspect the concerned vehicles to be disposed off in "as is where is condition" along with outstanding tax liabilities on any working day during the office hour.

The authority reserves right to accept or cancel any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.



Terms & Condition for disposal of condemned vehicles under the administrative control of Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer(CDM&PHO) Kendrapara, during financial year 2021-2022 in consonance to the provision led under Rule 23 of Orissa Govt Vehicles (Control & Uses) Rules-1978 at an earliest effect vis-a-vis with the procedure led under Rule-197 of the General Finance Rules-2005.

Published vide tender Notice No _____ dt _____

1.0. MATERIALS TO BE DISPOSED OFF.

- 1.1.** Condemned vehicles /Scrap vehicles are to be disposed as per location wise as under the Group Annexed.
- 1.2.** Condemned vehicles /Scrap vehicles are to be auctioned as per statement Annexed.
- 1.3.** The participants may inspect the vehicles during the official working hours with permission from the Chief district Medical Officer / other Head of the Institution / Medical Officer of PHC/ CHC etc.
- 1.4.** Vehicles will be sold in "as is where is condition with outstanding tax liabilities".
- 1.5.** Scrap items will be sold as per kg. rate which should be quoted.

2.0. TENDER FORMS.

- 2.1.** Tender shall be submitted in the "TENDER FORM " Annexed.
- 2.2.** Only **TENDER FORM** should be submitted. The terms and conditions and guideline for the tenderers should not be submitted with the TENDER FORM.
- 2.3.** The tenderers will clearly write the Group No.&Regd. No. in column prescribed, where they should quoting the rate . Any mistake noticed will be decided by the Tender screening committee and its decision will be final.
- 2.4.** The tenderers shall quote the rate visibly in words (Block letters and Numerical) to avoid confusion
- 2.5.** The tenderer intending for multiple tender shall use single tender form for single vehicle.
- 2.6.** The tender paper shall be submitted in sealed cover super scribed with "**TENDER FOR DISPOSAL OFF CONDEMNED VEHICLES for FY 2021-22**" with mention in detail address on the cover with their telephone No./ Mobile No. etc.
- 2.7.** All tenderers shall submit the tender by Registered post / Speed post only in the address as follows-

- 2.8.** Tender will be opened in the presence of not less that two valid tenderers or their representatives, on the stipulated date & time by the constituted Tender Screening Committee comprising of the following members of District level officers -

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3.0 EARNEST MONEY.

- 3.1. Rs. 1000-00 (Rupees one thousand)only for each vehicle will be treated as EMD. Even for the Registered Co-operative Society participates the tender have to furnish the E.M.D. Rs. 1000-00 (Rupees one thousand) only of each vehicle in the shape of B.D. as indicated in Para 3.2.
- 3.2. EMD shall be furnished in form of **Bank Draft** only in favour of the **Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer, Kendrapara** drawn at **S.B I. Main Branch, Kendrapara** and the same must be attached with the Tender Form.
- 3.3. To facilitate immediate refund of EMD the Tenderers should submit separate Bank Draft for each vehicle against which they have tendered with a stappled slip to each Bank Draft indicating vehicle No. If it is not done, the conducting authority (Chief District Medical &Public Health Officer, Kendrapara) may not be responsible for early refund of E.M.D. in case of successful tenderers. The EMD of second highest tenderers shall not be refunded until the successful tenderers deposit the full amount and the tender is finally decided in his favour.
- 3.4. E.M.D. of unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded after finalization of tender and within 30 days. No interest will be claimed by the tenderer.
- 3.5. Where a tenderer has submitted one Bank Draft covering more than one vehicle and if there is highest offer in respect of any vehicle the Bank Draft will be retained till final decision of the conducting authority.
- 3.6. Retention of EMD of the highest and second highest tenderers do not have guarantee that the decision will be in favour of the tenderers. The decision of the conducting officer shall be final.
- 3.7. The tenderer quoting the highest price or above the price approved by the authority will be asked to deposit 25% of the tender value on the day of opening of the tender by open announcement.
- 3.8. On failure to make final payment the aforesaid deposits (Including earnest money) of the tenderer shall be forfeited and the vehicle put to fresh tender as the case may be.
- 3.9. The tenderer should clearly mention their name and designation whether they may be Govt./ private organization.

4.0. PAYMENT ETC.

- 4.1. In the event of a tenderer not coming forward to deposit the rest 75 % amount due within 7 days i.e from the date of deposit of 25 % the conducting authority will be free to dispose the material to any other party and the E M D along with 25 % of tender value of the tenderer shall be liable forfeiture.
- 4.9. On receipt of intimation the tenderer will contact the concerned officer in the office of CDM&PHO, Kendrapara.for obtaining a money receipt after depositing the total amount due.
- 4.10. On payment of total amount, clearance will be issued by the CDM&PHO/ Head of Institution .

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- 4.11. No tender money will be accepted without the presence of the successful bidder or their authorized agents.
- 4.12. The vehicles will be handed over to the successful tenderer on receipt of full payment of the accepted tender money.
- 4.13. Tools and implements and spare parts shall not be delivered. R.C. book etc. which are not available shall not be delivered along with the vehicle.
- 4.14. The tenderer shall have to take the vehicle from the site mentioned against each, within 7 days after finalization of tender, custody and safety of the vehicle shall be the responsibility of the tenderer after it is finalized.

5.0. GROUND RENT.

- 5.1. In case of vehicle is not taken within the stipulated period, ground rent @ 1% of the tender money shall be charged for each day or part of the days till the vehicle is removed from the site.
- 5.2 Where the ground rent so charged exceeds the sale price deposited by the tenderer then he is ceased to have any right on the vehicle. The amount deposited by him shall be adjusted towards the ground rent and the vehicle shall become absolute property of Govt. and free from encumbrance and may be disposed by fresh tender or as per decision of conducting authority.

6.0 DISQUALIFICATION.

- 6.1 A tender may be summarily rejected by the screening committee for the following reasons.
 - a. Tender not submitted in the prescribed tender form.
 - b. Tender received beyond the date and time stipulated.
 - c. Tenders not submitted in closed sealed cover.
 - d. E.M.D. failing short of stipulated amount or without EMD
 - e. Sealed tender paper of any of the absentee tenderer may not be opened and returned to them seal in tact within 30 days.

7.0. CORRESPONDENCE.

- 7.1 All correspondence including the legal complication on the tender and disposal of the vehicle is to be complied by the concerned CDM&PHO / Head of the Institution.

8.0 AUTHORITY.

- 8.1 The authority reserves the right to accept or cancel any tender or all tenders without assigning any reason thereon & may settle the tender with the highest bidder on negotiation.
- 8.2 In case of dispute on any matter the interpretation & decision of the authority shall be final and binding and the legal procedures if any should be in the jurisdiction of the court of the state of Odisha.
